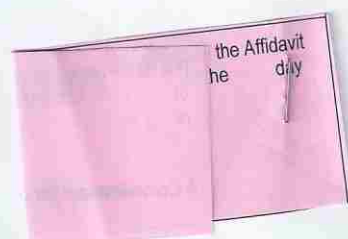


Minutes of Fiji Muslim league Council held at Mengania
Nadi on 12-08-07. As per the digital recorder.

- 1) Molvi Shahim recited the Quran tilawat.
- 2) The Speaker advised and informed that this is a special council meeting and to comply with all standing orders. The Speaker said he would not allow any personal abuse and very strict time will be allowed or conclude before zuhar salaah 12.30pm.
- 3) Notice of meeting convening moved by Nadi Branch.
- 4) Discussions were made on agenda:
 - 1- change item no: 8 to 9 and 9 to 8.
- 5) Apologise: Abdul Wahab JP, Makoi Muslim School manager Br. Shafiullah Khan, Secretary Suva Branch, Lauktoka Executives, Life member Abdul Razak Akbar, Abdul Gaffar, President Sabeto Branch, Vice President Abdul Hakim, Hafiz Musa Patel, Life Member M.T Ali and Saiyad Dean, Assistant General Secretary Mohammed Farooq.
- 6) The Speaker invited Magenia Branch President to Speak.
- 7) The Speaker asked did all Branch members get a copy of last council meeting minutes.
- 8) The Speaker asked the National President to speak.
- 9) Speaker discussed item number 6 of last council meeting:
 - 1- Nasinu Branch Objected on minutes of last council meeting item number 17, page number 5 and sub-item number 3 that this was never discussed that Nasinu Branch would reimburse \$8,000.00 in 14 days time:
 - 2- the General Secretary disputed the claim by Nasinu Branch. Br. Umar Farooq of Nasinu Branch strongly objected to the General Secretary on item number 17.
- 10) Nasinu Branch claimed that the 47 counts of allegations that were made on Nasinu Branch were missing from the last Council Meeting Minutes.



- 11) The speaker allowed the General Secretary to respond to this matter. The General Secretary said that the 47 counts of allegations were not part of the minutes and only the matters approved will appear in the minutes.
- 12) The Speaker agreed with Nasinu Branch and asked the General Secretary to amend last council minutes.
- 13) Minutes moved and accepted.
- 14) The Speaker allowed discussions on Board of Governors lead by Br. Maasud.
- 15) Nasinu Branch objected on implementing Board of Governors on all schools since its unconstitutional and suggested that any rules setup for branch schools should go through branch AGM or SGM.
- 16) The Speaker invited the Legal Advisor to clarify whether can FML have a paid school general manager, Nasinu Branch objected that it is unconstitutional for a general manager to be paid since it is a elected post and only members of FML are eligible to be elected as a general manager.
- 17) The Legal Advisor was not able to answer item number 16.
- 18) Nasinu Branch objected again any such rules for any branch schools have to go before branch AGM or SGM as it is a ministry requirement.
- 19) The Speaker agreed and it was resolved by the council that there will be no paid General Manager.
- 20) Next issue item number 9 was discussed which was discussions and deliberations on forty-seven counts of allegations on Nasinu Branch League.
- 21) The speaker allowed the inquiry committee chairman Mr. Faiyaz Koya to present his inquiry report on the forty-seven counts of allegation on Nasinu Branch.

- 22) The secretary of Nasinu Branch Mr. Feroz Gulam Mohammed objected that there was no inquiry carried by the appointed inquiry committee and how can the chairman present his inquiry report.
- 23) The speaker over-ruled Nasinu Branch secretary and told him to sit down, and was told you would be given chance to talk after the inquiry chairman presented his report.
- 24) The chairperson of the inquiry committee presented his report and made a recommendation to dissolve the current elected committee and an interim committee to run for at least two years.
- 25) The speaker allowed the Nasinu Branch Secretary to speak and the Branch Secretary made several points and asked the speaker as follows:
- a- why didn't the inquiry committee did the inquiry as per the council ruling that is within fourteen days of the last council meeting. Where the entire Nasinu Branch officials waited for the inquiry committee, leaving all their personal business affairs aside for fourteen days.
 - b- Why the Chairperson of the enquiry committee first wrote to Nasinu Branch secretary after a month and two days?
 - c- The branch management after receiving invitation letter from the inquiry committee chairman replied that the Branch management was ready to meet for full inquiry and for what reason the chairperson of the inquiry committee rejected the offer?
 - d- The Branch secretary said that the inquiry committee never met the entire Nasinu Branch officials and no inquiry was done.
- 26) The speaker asked the Nasinu Branch Secretary is there any other issues?
- 27) The Branch secretary said yes and said we shall be given a full chance to reply the forty-seven counts of allegations since the inquiry committee only wanted to investigate some of the

forty-seven counts of allegations.

- 28) The speaker said the branch was given more than enough time to present their defence and asked the branch secretary why the branch never submitted their submissions to the committee?
- 29) The branch secretary told the speaker that they can't give answers in yes or no they have to give reasons to justify.
- 30) the branch secretary said that they have made all efforts to abide by the council ruling that is invited the inquiry committee on the second day of council meeting and completed a defence or a submission on the forty-seven counts of allegations but the inquiry committee failed to comply with the council ruling. The other reason for not giving the submission to the inquiry committee was the branch prepared a full submission on the forty-seven counts of allegation but the inquiry committee wanted to only inquire on only some of the allegation and further said it was not a council ruling.
- 31) The chairperson of the inquiry committee was invited by the speaker to answer above questions to Nasinu Branch- the branch secretary told the chairperson of the inquiry committee that he was given fourteen days to do full inquiry and you have failed to do so, why?
- 32) The chairperson of the inquiry committee told that he had some personal problems and he could not meet but he did reply a month.
- 33) The chairperson of the inquiry committee started to shout and dictate which caused end of discussion.
- 34) Ba and Varavu branches passed remarks where heated arguments started between Nasinu and Ba, Vravu branches.
- 35) The speaker ruled that he will open the floor to make discussions and decisions and he will not allow any further submissions.
- 36) The Branch secretary told the speaker that if you are not allowing to table his defence on forty-seven counts of allegations

and natural justice then the branch has no option but to move out of this unconstitutional council meeting of FML.

- 37) The branch secretary together with all other branch officials stood up told the speaker that there is no justice in this totally unislamic meeting of FML.
- 38) The branch officials officially moved out of the council meeting.
