**RE: ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF FML ON 22.04.07**

Dear Brother in Islam,  
*Assalamu Alaikum Rahmatullahi Wabarkatuhu*

We totally disagree with the procedures used by the Speaker for Annual General Meeting of FML on 22.04.07.

In fact Br. Shafiullah Khan overruled the Speaker and created a scene, which resulted the Speaker to act what Ba, Varavu branches wanted.

The election was total unconstitutional and are as follows:

Irregularity of General election of FML held at Kamil Muslim College in Ba on 22.04.07.

1. The elected President Hafiz -Ud- Dean Khan does not comply to be a President of FML under clause of FML Constitution clause 5(a) 29(d).
  - a. Hafiz Khan has indirect/direct connection of selling alcohol and pork. Refer appendix 1.
  - b. A person involved in such activities does not comply to be a leader in Islam or even a member of Islam.
  - c. If a member of FML does not comply to be a leader in Islam then the Constitution does not allow him to be a President or even a member of FML.

2. The speaker wished to consult the Ulmas in above and other issue but he was over ruled by a member of Suva Branch (Mr. Tabiz), President of Varavu and Ba Branch and other supporters.

They said that speaker cannot talk to Ulma but he has to talk to Ulma Boards Chairperson Mr. Kaiyum Khan (who is not a Ulma) and he is the Vice president of FML (conflict if interest).

3. Mr. Kaiyum Khan does not comply to give Islamic issue judgment under the rules of FML Constitution clause 5(a).

4. Speaker carried out general consensus or election but failed to comply with the following:

- a. None of the Branches except Nasinu Branch had proper approval of their Management who to vote since their Management represent other branch members.
- b. None of the branch provided membership register of which one copy to be sent to FML Headquarters before 31<sup>st</sup> January of every year (clause 39(b)).
- c. The votes Mr. Speaker counted was based on verbal and assumption of paid members given by each Branch President and only Nasinu Branch presented full audited membership register.
- d. There was no document provided by other branches (apart from Nasinu) to the speaker to justify proper members and their votes.

5. That the President of Ba, Varavu and Secretary of FMSA abused and threatened the speaker and the speaker acted in under pressure and risk of threat. He was bullied.

6. That the President of Ba Branch threatened other small members branches that if they do not vote for Mr. Hafiz Khan then they will be kicked out of FML System.

7. That the President of varavu, Ba Branch damaged wheels of vehicle of President of Nasinu Branch.

### **RE: Corruption in Fiji Muslim League Management**

Please be informed that the current Fiji Muslim League (FML) Management is involved in many irregularities that might be of concern to your Jurisdictions, since tax payers funds are involved through Ministry of Education grants. We also want to highlight some of the many bulldozing tactics by the Speaker of FML, Mr. Faizal Koya and the National President of FML, Mr. Hafiz Khan in regards to matters relating to its member branches.

- A tender to construct a Shopping Complex for Fiji Muslim League was awarded to Hamids Construction. Many issues arise from this fraudulent practice:
  1. it was in total defiance to the Constitution of FML which does not allow any personal interest by any of its executive members, and please be informed that the proprietor of Hamids Construction was a working committee member when such tender was awarded to him (appendix-1);
  2. the tender which was awarded was \$900,000 more than another tender which was submitted by another Company (appendix-2);
  3. proper protocol was not followed in awarding the tender to Hamids Construction. For your information, the tender was supposed to be approved by the Council of FML, as per Constitutional requirement, but rather it was approved in the Working Committee of the League (appendix-3).
- Samabula Mosque is under construction and almost a million dollar has been spent on the project and yet the Mosque is only 80 percent complete. Please be advised that the initial budget for the project was \$600,000. Also note that money was collected to build the mosque but some part of it was diverted to build quarters. A motion was moved before the Council of FML by Nasinu Branch but was never addressed by the Council (appendix-4)
- Islamic Institute ended in bankruptcy due to mismanagement by FML Management and as a result Nasinu Muslim Primary School is mortgaged. Despite several attempts by FML member branches demanding for an inquiry in

the mismanagement and closure of the Institute, the President of FML has refused to allow such investigation to take place.

- It should be made aware to you that every Muslim School Management (Branch Management) pays \$2 per student annually, to the FML Management Board from the funds received as Education Grants from your Ministry for no apparent reason. Nasinu Branch moved a motion before the Council of FML to justify the payment of approximately \$450,000 from Ministerial grants to FML Management for the past 12 years by all the Muslim Schools under its banner, and had also demanded an audit report of where the money was utilized, but till date, the motion has not been addressed before the Council. Please refer appendix 5 – 8 attached herewith.
- Every year approximately \$10,000 is transferred to FML Management account from the Ministerial funds allocated to Kamil Muslim College for the past 18 years without any justification (appendix-9). Also note that the 2006 financial accounts of Kamil Muslim College presented to your Ministry has entries such as General Expense with big amounts without any clarification (appendix-10-11). For the past 18 years the said school is governed by the BOG but as per constitutional requirement of FML, it has to be governed by an elected committee from its constituency (appendix-12).
- The 2007 Annual General Meeting of FML at Kamil Muslim College has many unconstitutional elements. Please refer appendix 13 attached herewith.
- 2006 FML financial report has many discrepancies and reflects abuse of funds by FML Management League. Please refer appendix 14-15.
- Despite several attempts to take 2 branch members namely, John Asgar Ali and Mohammed Hanif, who were involved in mismanagement of approximately \$12,000 in 2006 to Dispute Resolution Committee, the President of FML has used bulldozing tactics to deny such request (appendix 16-18).

Sir, these are only a few of the many corrupt practices being adopted by FML Management. Since our election and appointment as Nasinu Branch officials in 2005, FML Management and Trustees constantly conspired to suspend, terminate or dissolve the branch officials because we were constantly demanding FML Management to justify to many of their dishonest practices and abuse of authority. In the last Council meeting of 12/08/07 at Mangania Nadi we were not allowed to present our defense on 47 counts of allegations made by the General Secretary of FML and as a result we had no option but to work out of the Council meeting. Many of these issues were forwarded to Anti Corruption Unit in the beginning of 2007, but till date nothing has materialized.


Sir, we request for your immediate intervention in these matters and wish for an inquiry committee to investigate these allegations. Should you need any further clarification on

Mr. Secretary when I received this letters I called some brothers of Nasinu branch and believe me we are in a state of shock.


Now I am requesting you if we could have the following documents in order to discuss this issue in our executive and write back to Viti Levu Construction Fiji Ltd and get our minds clear.

I wish to loge a complain on above college. My son is a student there and they are forced to be involved in fundraising especially the Board of Governors and the Principle himself. Suva Muslim college has been involved in fundraising for the last fifteen years and there is no accountability or transparency. If I am not wrong executives of Suva Muslim College have been convicted and been removed twice in misuse of funds. Last year they carried out a large fundraising and being a Muslim school they even promoted adultery. I wrote to the Fiji Muslim League and the Principle but they haven't replied till today, as you know the system is corrupt. Fiji Muslim league's President Mr. Hafiz- Ud-Dean himself promotes illegal fundraising activities because he was the chief guest in the last years fundraising.

Now the story is this that whatever funds was collected last year by hardworking students, was basically distributed between some of the Board of Governors and Raiwai Builders. Raiwai builders got a contract to build an indoor sports facility but unfortunately before they were able to attach the roof the roof collapsed and I believe a staff died. The sports facility where the proposed building was being constructed, which collapsed, was on the site of the old tennis court that was built by a former Student Council of Suva Muslim College and now it is of no use. Now the question is that will Raiwai Builders return the entire money but I believe they will only return half and the other half will go in someone else's pocket. This is totally unjustified and now they have started another fundraising this year and there is no transparency of where the previous and current funds are.


Now I ask the Ministry why do they have to allow children to be involved in such kinds of fundraisings since they are paying building, development and stationary. If there is a need for fundraising why cant there be transparency in the system. Why can't these corrupt people be removed from these institutes?

Your letter content is baseless, wrong and full of hatred.

- 1) Fiji Muslim League- Nasinu Branch will never withdraw suspension on Br. Subhan and Br. Hanif. They are gone- history.
- 2) Any Branch can hold any meetings at any time.
  - A- Under branch rules page 32, item 9. It say all general meetings, it doesn't say Annual General Meeting only.
  - B- Page 3 item 5 A and B allows us to follow the rules of Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) and doing general mashora (meeting) is 100% legal. (council meeting in Rakiraki in 2006, objection was on Br. Safiullah Khan to be speaker. It was ruled that rules of Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) allow us and he was speaker for that council meeting).

- 2) How did you brothers borrow Finance from the bank on interest?
- 3) How can Br. Hakim hold 3 positions that is Board of Governors chairperson, chairperson of development and Vice president of Fiji Muslim League?
- 4) Why you brothers hiding seven bank account details as mentioned on our motion?
- 5) Why you brothers are not providing information to branches or to the council that complimentary Hajj tickets are given and who are the brothers going on F.O.C.
- 6) Why you brothers are not bringing our pending motion before the council?
- 7) Without branch concern and council approval who authorized to mortgage our branch property on interest?
- 8) There was a special General meeting conducted by Nasinu Branch on 18/03/01 and on 24/04/01 (I have got copy of minutes as evidence) why was it not necessary then to get a council approval?


