Assalam Alaikum Warahmatullahi Wabarkatuhu



Assalamu 'Alaikum Wa Rahmatullahi Wa Barakatuhu

Re : Purchase of duty free vehicle

We refer to your letter dated 12/2/07 concerning purchase of vehicle and our response there to whereby you were advised that your letter dated 12/2/07 was referred to Board of Islamic Affairs for a ruling AND we will communicate with you upon receipt of Board of Islamic Affairs ruling.

We advise Board of Islamic Affairs made a ruling on 28/3/07. An extract of the ruling is reproduced hereunder :-

"FML Nasinu branch Use of Mosque for the Purchase of vehicle.

The branch purchased a duty free vehicle worth \$11,000.00 (eleven thousand dollars) utilizing \$8,000.00 (eight thousand dollars) from the Mosque fund. Fiji Muslim League management board wants clarifications in this issue .

That the Board of Islamic Affairs members had carefully looked at the documents presented to them by the Branch and are not satisfied with the explanation given by the branch regarding the purchase of the van from the Mosque fund and using it for the purpose mentioned by the branch.

The members also noted

1. The Board of Islamic Affairs was not consulted prior to the purchasing of the vehicle.
2. That the board is now asking the branch to refund the total amount used from the mosque fund and within 14 (fourteen) days from the date of letter.
3. That the branch shall not use the vehicle until the money issue is resolved."



Please comply with the above mentioned resolution and advise us as soon as the total amount used from the mosque fund is refunded.

We also advise Br Asgar Ali raised his concern in writing concerning the purchase of a vehicle from Mosque account. In response to his concerns we have made available to him a copy of Board of Islamic Affairs ruling.

 - (b) driving or being carried in or upon or entering or getting on to or alighting from the said motor vehicle except in so far as the indemnity granted hereby must apply by reason of Sub - section (1) of Section 6 of the Ordinance when the liability of the Insurer shall be limited to the minimum amounts referred to in the Proviso to the said Sub - section of the said Ordinance.
- (2) This Policy does not cover (a) any liability which arises solely by virtue of the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance or (b) any contractual liability. This Policy does not cover any liability in respect of any occurrence which happens when the motor vehicle is being used for any purpose other than those for which premium has been paid as stated in paragraph 5 above.


